Twenty-Nine New York Airports Receive FAA Airport Infrastructure Grants

NYAMA President Christina Callahan and the association's Board lauded the U.S. Department of Transportation's June 5 announcement awarding nearly \$38 million in Airport Improvement Program (AIP) grants to 29 airports across New York. A total of 45 grants were awarded, with several airports receiving more than one grant.

"These grants provide secure funding source for dozens of important projects at airports across the state, supplying critical assistance to the breadth of our membership, from our smallest facilities to some of our busiest, and they will ensure we maintain the highest levels of service for millions of customers who rely on us," Callahan said.

Projects in New York that will be funded in this latest round of AIP grants include environmental studies, taxiway construction, critical maintenance and rehabilitation, and the acquisition of new snow removal equipment.

Airports are eligible to receive a certain amount of AIP entitlement funding each year based on activity levels and project needs. If a capital project's funding needs exceed available entitlement funds, the FAA can supplement entitlements with discretionary funding.
